- **Concussion Policy Discussion:** Mary Fisher reported that the subcommittee has been working to get the Return to Learn finalized. Information is currently available on the KGCS Health Web Page. Nurses from KGMS and KGHS stated that they have already seen several students being treated for concussions this school year. The committee discussed at length some of the challenges that families face in obtaining post concussion care. More effective ways of staff communication were discussed as well to help promote more collaboration for IHPs post concussion.
 - **Train the Trainer:** As subcommittee was formed to prepare computer based learning modules for staff education in the Fall. A "hands on" portion will also be provided at each school for staff on Stop the Bleed, Epi pen, AED, Diabetes care and Hands only CPR.
 - **Tdap Clinic Report** Michelle Cantrell wasn't able to attend but reported via email that the clinics went well at each elementary school. They would like to expand next year and possibly offer HPV and Meningitis immunizations as well.
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Information Items & Round table Discussion

- All team members concurred that STD's are still a big concern. The committee will continue to explore resources that meet the Family Life SOLs to educate our students.
- Summer school will be employing a nurse for 4 hours a day this year for the first time.
- Mary Fisher gave a report of her 2 year efforts on obtaining resources for assist our families in obtaining the mandatory physical prior to school entry. She has been given a contact at VDH to help facilitate this process. Local resources are also being explored.
- MAT training for non nurse subs was discussed. Committee will research.
- Scoliosis screenings as a pilot were discussed for the Spring 2019 at KGMS. Nurse Brouillette will research this further to check on liability and consent forms.
- Caredocs approached KGCS about offering a Flu Shot clinic for KGCS students. Mary Fisher and Belinda Cameron did a phone conference with them to discuss the feasibility. Currently there are no school systems in Virginia using this company. So the committee felt we would not be able to properly vet them at this time. The committee decided not to pursue this service for next school year.
