- Approximately 85 students enrolled at the elementary level, reviewed benchmark test scores for students enrolled and noticed a positive trend.

- Approximately $25 \%$ of Kindergarten students began school recognizing less than 6 letters. Reviewed ways to inform or encourage families to support letter recognition before kindergarten.
