

BOARD MEMBERS ORIENTATION

Within two weeks following his or her appointment (through 1995) or election (beginning November 1995), each new School Board member shall receive an intensive orientation under the direction of the Superintendent. Included shall be a current copy of the policy manual, the budget, a directory of the School Division, the Virginia school laws, including the Virginia Freedom of Information Act, job descriptions, payroll database, supplemental assignments, salary scales, calendars, and other documents deemed essential to an understanding of the operation of the School Division. The Superintendent shall set aside such time as is necessary to answer any questions arising from the study of these documents and shall cooperate fully in assisting the new member to become an informed and active Board member.
