KING GEORGE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS WAIVER OF STUDENT SUPERVISION

ELEMENTARY STUDENT SUPERVISION

A student in kindergarten may not be allowed to disembark a King George County School bus unless the student is met/supervised by a parent or pre-approved individual, above the age of 12-twelve. Students in grade one and through the age of nine may not be allowed to disembark a King George County School bus unless:

- O The student (grade one through the age of nine) is met/supervised by a parent or an individual authorized by the parent, above the age of 12-twelve.
- The parent has signed and returned this Waiver of Student Supervision to the transportation department.

I understand that if this release is not on file with the transportation department, my student will be returned to the attending school. Bus drivers will not permit students to disembark the school bus at stops other than the student's regular bus stop unless written permission is submitted to the school by the parent and the school forwards the information to the bus driver. Should the environment at any bus stop where a student has not been met, appear to be insecure, the bus driver will have the right to notify the Transportation Department and return the student back to school.
