SCHOOL BUS SAFETY

<u>Accident Procedures</u>: Following are the procedures to be initiated when any school bus or school vehicle is involved in an accident while transporting students:

- <u>Driver</u> 1. Call Transportation Supervisor (775-7531), via mobile radio or by dialing Director of Business (775-5833) or Superintendent (775-5833). (The person in charge).
 - 2. Do not discuss the accident with the other party; speak to Deputy Sheriff or Transportation Designee only.
- Person In 1. Call principal of school to inform him/her of the accident, location of the accident, and the number of students on board.
 - 2. Transportation will contact emergency personnel to respond to the accident if needed.
 - 3. If treatment of students or driver is needed, the Supervisor of Transportation will make arrangements with the school designee.
 - 4. Give names of children to the principal or his designee.
- Principal Call parents to inform them of accident and procedures in effect. or Designee

Children shall remain on the bus until the parent or a school employee removes them. This will not apply if the bus accident presents a dangerous situation that would jeopardize the safety of the children or bus driver remaining on the bus.

It is impossible to cover all situations; therefore, use of common sense and logic is required.

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
