## 2 Focus Topic: Planning for Middle School Services – Amanda Higgins:

- A. Coordinating trips to Stafford and Caroline in February/March 2019.
  - a. Purpose: the move of Sixth Grade to the Middle School
  - b. Determine what needs to be provided in the form of gifted services with the new middle school configuration.
  - c. Dustin Pifer suggests speaking with staff and what all they implement in the form of gifted services, rather than interrupt lessons.
  - d. Caroline County provides a pull out during the enrichment and intervention program with the Gifted Services Resource Teacher sit in on a 20-minute session.
  - e. Amanda Higgins will schedule upcoming visits with Stafford and Caroline County Gifted Services.

## 3 Coordinator's Report – Amanda Higgins:

- A. All Gifted Referrals are due on or before February 15, 2019. Any referrals received after February 15 will roll over to the next school year.
- B. MAP testing currently underway at all three elementary schools, this is the screening method with which to identify students for gifted services. 96% and above are referred for gifted services. Cover letters are being sent to teachers for referrals for fall evaluation.
- C. Governor Schools:
  - a. Chesapeake Bay Governor's School (CGBS) and Commonwealth Governor's School (CGS) are in assessment phase at present time. There are over 30 applicants for Governor's School this year.
  - b. Summer Residential Programs for grades 10 and 11
  - c. Fredericksburg Regional Governor's School for grades 6-11 applications are not available yet, expected in February 2019 and are due around Mid-March.
- D. STEM day trip for gifted students 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade to Commonwealth Governor's School for half a day event. Older students mentoring younger students. Wednesday January 23, 2019.
- E. STEM night to be held Mid-March dinner provided at 4:30 p.m., event from 5-7 p.m. STEM night to be held at the High School due to current construction at the Middle School.
- F. Gifted Center Open House to be held in May 2019: Contact parents directly to invite them to the open house at King George Elementary School through letter and perhaps a follow up phone call or school messenger. Inform parents this is an important event for the students to meet the teachers and participate in a project while parents meet in the library for a
