- VSTE
 - Attended by ITLs & Supervisor of Technology, Student Database Manager attended
- The Pandemic
 - Technology Department response to the shutdown
 - Challenging, distributed several devices and hotspots to students and families
 - 2021 Summer Recovery
 - Clean, update, repair all the devices
 - Students can check out devices at elementary level for quarantine situations
 - Secondary is able to check out devices (like a textbook) to 6-12th grade
 - Student checkout has gone very smoothly @ KGMS
 - Current Status (1:1) Secondary
 - Teachers currently have access to 1 desktop in every classroom, and 1 staff chromebook/per employee (K-12)
 - 6-12 is 1:1
 - Carts of CBs shared among teams..looking to move to a 1:1 cart per classroom setting
- 2022 Semester 2 Initiative/Pilot
 - Goal: Transition secondary teacher devices from desktop to laptop
 - What is the goal? What is the vision?
 - Possible transition all 3 elementary schools to 1:1 by classroom cart
 - 2017 Staff were given division CBs
 - Most staff would like to have a laptop instead of a CB
 - Concern with small screens Keep existing monitor, mouse, keyboard
 - HS desktops are in need of replacement
 - Possible pilot next semester: 20-30 laptops with about 10 going to MS & 10 to HS
 - Laptops will have wired connections to the network

 - Old plan is expiring, a new plan needs to be created, work on incorporating with the division strategic plan
 - Look at where we want to be in 5 years
