- 2. Nomination of GAC Chair and Secretary Robin Mitchell volunteered to continue as Secretary. Terri Rinko nominated Corrine Graves for Chair. The committee agreed to send out an email to elicit votes.
- Current gifted model at each school:

Elementary - Mr. Pifer reported that Mrs. Murgas has assumed the gifted teacher role vacated by Mrs. Burke. He said he is noticing a decrease in ability this year compared to past years. Returning to hands-on learning from online projects since COVID. Mrs. Murgas explained the program for the 3rd, 4th, and 5th-grade students. Mr. Pifer expressed a desire for professional development for teachers that have not occurred in recent years. K-2 has one student identified as gifted. The plan is to get into 2nd grade classes before testing with lessons and to expose students to similar analogies as the OLSAT. CoGAT was discussed as an alternative option. Our K-2 OLSAT booklets have not been updated in years, but the updates reportedly have not been significant enough to justify the purchase.

Secondary - Mrs. Hill explained that Mrs. Higgins used to go to each school's faculty meeting to provide information to teachers about the gifted program. The committee discussed ways to share the information with teachers this school year through a google form, slides with audio recordings, and faculty meetings. The committee discussed the pros and cons of adjusting the parameters of the eligibility process. An additional test after 2nd grade was discussed potentially in 6th grade as the test can be used for Governor's School for two years.
