Secondary - Mr. McNamara described the advanced math middle school curriculum and course offerings. The CGS and CBGS Parent Information Session was held November 10, 2022. Applications have been made available to students and are due prior to the winter break. Interviews will be held in January and February. Summer residential applications are available now and have been advertised. Mrs. Graves announced that she is the coordinator for the Summer Regional Governor's School Program. Updated applications will be available soon. High school and middle school students may apply if they are identified.

The committee discussed how CGS students who have not been identified as gifted can be eligible for the summer programs. The division website contains detailed information for families and staff to review.

5. Suggestions for summer programs and I/E to broaden the talent pool: Discussion has occurred among the gifted team regarding a one-two week gifted enrichment that coincides with summer school. A suggestion was made to consider hiring current CGS and CBGS students to support this program. Discussion included potential opportunities for students who may capture students working at an advanced level.

6. Review Local Gifted Plan. Committee members took parts to review before the meeting. Members were also asked to verify the VA Code referenced is still accurate. The committee decided to postpone this discussion until the next meeting.
