<i>First Aid, CPR, AED Training Certs.</i>	These will be done through Vector. You will be able to log in using your email address after your first day of work. These are 3 separate trainings. Please print all 3 certificates. Note: If you are Red Cross or American Heart Association certified in CPR/AED and First Aid, you may submit a copy of your valid certification to meet licensure requirements.	Everyone

<i>Civics Training Cert.</i>	www.civiceducationva.org Any individual licensed and endorsed to teach (i) middle school civics or economics or (ii) high school government or history who is seeking renewal of such license is required to demonstrate knowledge of Virginia history or state and local government by completing a module or professional development course specifically related to Virginia history or state and local government that has a value of five professional development points. Successful completion of the Virginia State and Local Civic Education Module will satisfy this renewal requirement.	Any teacher seeking a teaching license/endorsement in middle school History/Social Studies or 6-12 History/Social Studies; some elementary teachers may be asked to complete.
